Special Attributes

Zones:

- 98% of the catchment zoned Public Conservation and Resource.
- 1.5% of the catchment zoned Environmental Rural.
- 0.5% of the catchment zoned Township and Public Use.

Overlays:

- Erosion management (covering the Environmental Rural Zone)
- Land subject to inundation (river flats near township)
- Special building (covering the Environmental Rural and Township Zones)
- Wildfire management (most of Environmental Rural and Township Zones)

<u>Australian grayling:</u> The fish species with the greatest conservation need in the Otway region.

<u>Tourism:</u> Outside Melbourne, the Great Ocean Road is Victoria's most popular tourist destination, attracting between 12 and 14 percent of all domestic and international visitors within the state. The value of tourism in the Great Ocean Road tourist region was estimated to be \$940 million.
